

PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy ("Policy") discloses the privacy practices for Cascada Silver Corp. ("Cascada"). The Policy applies to our website and any associated services. The aim of this policy is to inform you of the following:

- What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the web site, how
 it is used and with whom it may be shared.
- What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
- The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
- How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Information Collection

We collect your personal data in the following ways:

Information Use

We collect this information for these purposes:

Information Sharing

Disclosure to Law Enforcement

We may disclose information to law enforcement agencies without further consent or notification upon a lawful request from such agencies. We will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies.

Your Access to and Control over Information

In accordance to the General Data Protection Regulation or GDPR, we have implemented additional transparency on how you have access and control over your information. As available and except as limited under applicable law, the rights afforded to individuals are:

- Right to Restrict the right to request that we temporarily or permanently stop
 processing all or some of your personal data;

Right to Object

- the right, at any time, to object to us processing your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation;
- the right to object to your personal data being processed for direct marketing purposes;
- **Right to Data Portability** the right to request a copy of your personal data in electronic format and the right to transmit that personal data for use in another party's service;
- Right not to be subject to Automated Decision-making the right to not be subject to a decision based solely on automated decision making, including profiling, where the decision would have a legal effect on you or produce a similarly significant effect.

In order to enable you to exercise these rights with ease you may contact us at any time to make changes to the information we maintain.

For your protection, we only fulfill requests for the information associated with the particular email address that you use to send us your request, and we may need to verify your identity before fulfilling your request. We will try to comply with your request as soon as reasonably practicable.

Data Retention and Deletion

We keep your personal data only for legitimate and essential business purposes, such as complying with our legal obligations, and resolving disputes. If you request, we will delete or anonymize your personal data so that it no longer identifies you, unless, we are legally allowed or required to maintain certain personal data, including situations such as the following:

- Where we are required to retain the personal data for our legal, tax, audit, and accounting obligations, we will retain the necessary personal data for the period required by applicable law; and/or,
- Where necessary for our legitimate business interests such as fraud prevention or tomaintain the site security.
